Project Title: «Reinforcing the institution of professional supervision of unaccompanied minors»,
IRS 5045763

Short description: This Project aims in ensuring the protection of all unaccompanied minors living all over Greece, either in long-term accommodation structures (shelters & protected apartments) or in short-term ones such as safe zones within open refugee camps, hotels, in Reception and Identification Centers, protective supervision of the homeless or in unsafe accommodation conditions, prioritizing vulnerable cases, in the regional units of Attica, Piraeus and Aegean, Macedonia and Thrace, Thessaly and Mainland Greece, Peloponnese, Crete, Epirus and Western Greece. More specifically, the Project includes: 1) hiring 180 Professional Supervisors and 20 Coordinators for the support of the Professional Supervisors, as well as their inclusion in the Professional Supervisors Registry, 2) the Supervisors' training through initial and ongoing seminars, 3) supporting the operation of the Supervision through a systematic supervision of each professional Supervisor, 4) developing and updating an electronic platform aiming that the new system will support three registries (unaccompanied minors, supervisors and accommodation centers) and the coordination and monitoring of the Supervisors' work, as well as 5) ensuring the proper equipment for the Supervisor's work and 6) providing representation services to unaccompanied minors according to Law 4636/2019, for a transition period of 8 months, during which all organizational and operational needs will be covered.

Through this project, the NCSS aims to develop a body of professional supervisors, which act for the unaccompanied minors' best interest in services and resources such as safe accommodation, medical care, education and protection in our country. The expected benefits of the Project are: a) the support of the implementation of the Supervision's institutional framework, as stated by law through the development of a supervision system which promotes core values, b) the support of the unaccompanied minors' protection system through the creation of a Professional Supervisors Registry, the Unaccompanied Minors Registry and the Accommodation Centers Registry, c) supporting the Unaccompanied Minors Protection Directorate that was established in the National Centre for Social Solidarity (NCSS) and d) informing the cooperating actors and bringing awareness to the public regarding the Supervision institution

Inclusion Budget: The total budget is 7.409.140,48€, of which a 75% by the European Union and 25% θα by national funds.
